

PRIVACY DISCLOSURE

This information is provided pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016 by Deep Vision Consulting srl viale Vittorio Veneto 2, 41124 Modena as Data Controller to those who, through the form on the "Contacts" page, requesting information regarding the services and products provided by Deep Vision Consulting srl authorizes the writer to process their personal data. The provision of data is optional, the refusal to provide data implies the impossibility of processing and following up on requests received.

Purpose of the treatment

The personal data provided by the users are used in order to follow up the requests of the users themselves and to send news and services regarding the company. The data provided may be used for sending commercial communications and news on the activity of Deep Vision Consulting srl

Legal basis

The personal data provided by users are lawfully processed to give effect to the legitimate interest of the owner himself (art.6, par . 1, letter f), of Regulation 679/2016) and to respond to user requests.

Recipients of the data

The personal data provided by users will not be disclosed to third parties in any way. They may be communicated to employees and collaborators of the Data Controller who will treat them in compliance with the instructions given by the Data Controller.

Data retention

Pursuant to articles 13, paragraph 2, and from 15 to 21 of the Regulation, we inform you that regarding the processing of your personal data you can exercise the following rights:

A - Right to obtain access to personal data and to the following information:

- confirmation that the processing of personal data is in progress;
- the purposes of the treatment;
- the categories of personal data;
- the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated;
- if the data are not collected from the interested party, all information available on their origin;
- the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling;
- a copy of the personal data being processed.

B - Right to rectification and integration of personal data

C - Right to erasure of data ("right to be forgotten") if one of the following reasons exists:

- personal data are no longer necessary with respect to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - the interested party revokes consent to the processing of data and there is no other legal basis for the processing;
 - the interested party opposes the treatment and there is no prevailing legitimate reason to proceed with the treatment;
 - personal data have been unlawfully processed;
 - personal data must be deleted to fulfill a legal obligation under Union or Member State law to which the data controller is subject.
- The data controller, if he has made personal data public and is obliged to delete them, must inform the other owners who process the personal data of the request to delete any link, copy or reproduction of his data.

D - Right to limit the processing the event that:

- the interested party disputes the accuracy of personal data, for the period necessary for the data controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data;
- The treatment is illegal and the interested party opposes the cancellation of personal data and instead requests that their use be limited;
- Although the data controller no longer needs it for processing purposes, personal data are necessary for the interested party to ascertain, exercise or defend a right in court;
- the interested party opposed the processing, pending verification of the possible prevalence of the legitimate reasons of the data controller with respect to those of the interested party.

E - Right to lodge a complaint with the Guaranteur for the protection of personal data, following the procedures and indications published on the official website of the Authority [Garante Privacy](#)

F - Right to portability of the data of the interested party or the right to receive in a structured format, commonly used and readable by automatic device the personal data concerning him provided to a data controller and possibly transmit them to another data controller treatment, if the treatment is based on consent or on a contract and is carried out by automated means. Where technically possible, the interested party has the right to obtain the direct transmission of data from one data controller to another.

G - Right to object at any time to the processing of personal data, including profiling, in particular in the event that:

- the processing takes place on the basis of the legitimate interest of the owner, subject to an explanation of the reasons for the opposition;
- personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes.

H - Right not to be subjected to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, except in cases where the decision is necessary for the conclusion or execution of a contract between the interested party and a data controller, is authorized by Union or Member State law to which the data controller is subject or is based on the explicit consent of the data subject.

I - Right to withdraw consent at any time; the data, if not based on another legal basis (including, fulfillment of a legal obligation or execution of a contract) must be deleted by the owner.

The exercise of rights is not subject to any form constraint and is free of charge.

How to exercise the rights

The interested party may at any time exercise the rights by sending:
